My dear MacB,

You will remember my speaking to you of our desire to verify the records of those students and graduates of McGill University who served in the War. We are preparing for publication a list of graduates and undergraduates of McGill University who served, and we are particularly anxious to have the list as nearly correct as possible. The great majority served of course in the Canadian Army, and if we could get access to your records we could not only check up the list we have, but also find out what names should be added. To this end it would be necessary to look up perhaps six thousand names.

Would you kindly let me know whether it is possible to have access to the records either from an accredited representative of the University or by some arrangement which you might make? If it is impossible for you to detail a member of the Department of Records to check up the list we might send you. I was wondering if you could suggest somebody familiar with the routine of the Records Office whom we could employ. I thought that maybe someone formerly familiar with that routine may be out of work now and looking for employment. If he were capable and trustworthy we would be willing to engage him for the time necessary to check over the names we would send. If a man at present on the staff could do the work out of hours we will be quite willing to give him a decent bonus. What have you to suggest?







Dear Sir Arthur,

This Library has recently received a copy of the "McGill Honour Roll".

There is no indication in the book as to author, or Committee of publication. The statement on the title page is, "Published by McGill University, in honour of those who served in the Great War". In the absence of more specific information I am, therefore, acknowledging this appreciated gift to yourself, as Principal, and would like you to pass on the thanks of this University to those more immediately responsible.

This Library is now in possession of a goodly number of such memorial volumes, from both Canadian and English universities. I do not think, however, that we have received any that is as beautiful as the one issued in memory of McGill's student body. Whoever is responsible for its production is to be congratulated. It is a worthy memorial of a splendid record.

That over three thousand men should have enlisted, and that between three hundred and four hundred should have given up their lives while in military service, is a fact that should at once sober and inspire all the present and future sons of McGill. I remember being on your Campus in the autumn of 1915, coming up after my course at the Library School to meet your then Librarian, Mr. Gould, and to look over your Library. The Campus had been transformed into a drill ground - the lawns were trampled by marching feet; little squads of men were being instructed in bayonet practice; and all sorts of military training activities were in progress. These young fellows were even then preparing "To give up the years to be, Of comfort and of joy" - and now many of them lie in Flanders field. The pathos, the tragedy, the stupidity of it all! When will we learn "How good and pleasant a thing it is for men to dwell together in peace and unity"? But the insensate and intrinsic folly of war detracts no whit from the heroism of those who voluntarily take its risks. And we who remain do well to do proud and tender honour to the memory of all who fell in perhaps one of the most necessary, as it was beyond question the greatest, war of all times.



Yet, despite the magnitude of our debt to these men, our impressions are shallow, and we soon forget. To some of us, the memories of the War are burnt deep and ineffacable, but already a generation is springing up whose souls the war touches little or not at all. It is for these that cenotaphs have to be erected - and it is a pity that on every one there ought to be engraved the quotation that is cut into the one in Vancouver, - "It is nothing to you all ye that pass by?". And it is for the newer generations that memorial volumes recording heroic service have to be compiled. They are at once a debt owed to the dead, and either an inspiration or a rebuke to the courage or thoughtlessness of the living. And, if such memorial volumes are necessary, it is fitting that they should be done as well as it is possible to do them. And this meed of praise can certainly not be withheld from the one issued by your University.



YALE WAR MEMORIAL



“The tumult and the shouting dies—
Lord God of Hosts be with us yet,
Lest we forget, lest we forget.”

A GRAY, rainy Sunday last January, Bishop Brent—addressing the men of one of our combat divisions, formed on the fields of France to render homage to their dead—spoke of their brothers in arms who in hospital or field had laid down their lives, and in that supreme sacrifice had won for themselves our undying love and that highest emblem of service—the decoration of the wooden cross.

For those of our own brothers—sons of Yale, our Alma Mater—who went out, some from the shelter of her place, some from the shelter of their homes, to meet death with clear vision and clear courage in this great war, it is now purposed to erect a memorial; that it may be to them a tribute and a token of our love; to us and to those who shall come after, an abiding memory of their steadfast faith and sacrifice; an enduring symbol of that strong spirit which our Mother breeds in her sons—the willingness to die that justice and truth and freedom shall live.

There is no man among us who has not felt the touch of this sorrow; who has not known the inspiration wrought by the gift these men freely made.

There is none who will not wish in such manner as he can, to have his part in this expression of a new dedication of the living to those ideals for which these—our dead—poured out so freely the last full measure of devotion.

Is it not today more essential than ever before that no opportunity be neglected to instill into the minds of our youth, to new generations of leaders, the duty and glory of sacrifice and a steady knowledge of our best traditions?

YALE WAR MEMORIAL

THE project to erect a Memorial was started last June and took definite form in the Resolution of the Alumni Advisory Board as follows:

“RESOLVED, that the Alumni Advisory Board recommend that the Corporation shall erect on behalf of the University suitable tablets in memory of Yale men who gave their lives in the war, and that the Alumni erect, at their own expense, a dignified and appropriate Memorial commemorative of this sacrifice and that this be done as speedily as possible; that the central thought in determining the character of the proposed Memorial shall be that it express the sentiment of the Alumni, rather than serve any utilitarian purpose.”

The same day the Corporation “RESOLVED, that the recommendations of the Alumni Advisory Board be approved,” and also authorized the Executive Committee of the Alumni Advisory Board to take such steps as necessary to put the project into immediate effect.

At its September meeting the Executive Committee “VOTED, that the Committee favors raising immediately a sum of \$150,000 for the erection, with suitable setting, of a Memorial to the Yale men who have lost their lives in the great war and inviting a few of the most distinguished sculptors in the country to offer designs as soon as the site has been determined by the Corporation, with the understanding that each of the invited sculptors shall receive a suitable honorarium, and with the further understanding that the winning design shall be selected by the Committee, with the approval of the Yale Corporation, after due consultation with professional advisers of the highest standing in the fields of sculpture and of architecture.

“VOTED, that the Chairman be authorized to appoint a Committee to prepare a program for the proposed competition.

“VOTED, that the Chairman be authorized to appoint a Committee to raise the necessary funds, with power to employ an executive Secretary.”

And so this Committee, as authorized in the last paragraph, comes to you to explain what is contemplated and with a proposition to act as the medium of your coöperation. Just where our Memorial will be located we cannot as yet definitely tell you. The Alumni Advisory Board voted:

"That as at present advised the Committee strongly favors erecting a Memorial in the University Quadrangle (South of the Dining Hall and at the head of University Avenue) believing that this site is the most central and the most appropriate in the University; and that the Committee is prepared to secure plans for a Memorial on this site as soon as it has been formally approved by the Yale Corporation and its architectural advisers."

The Executive Committee on Memorials has endorsed this location. The Committee now rests with the Corporation to await the report on Future Architectural Development of the University of its new Committee on Architectural Plans.

It is the strong feeling of those who have given this subject their careful thought that, in order that the Memorial correctly interpret the spirit and feeling of the men and the cause for which the Memorial is to be erected, the project be executed now, at once, while all the patriotic fervor, the sternness, the horror, the dread and the elation of the days we have just passed through, and the peril so dearly averted, are part and parcel of our being.

It is the high privilege of this Committee to be called upon to raise this fund of \$150,000, as outlined in the foregoing Resolutions. For the purpose of bringing this to the knowledge of every Yale man a copy of this appeal is being sent out to every Yale graduate and undergraduate the world over.

But for the actual collection of funds it is deemed most important that different Alumni groups accept definite responsibilities and for Yale men to be canvassed by the Alumni Association located in the district where they live, and that subscriptions be sent to the central Committee through the person designated by each Alumni Association for the reception of contributions.

Your name has therefore been given to the Alumni Association in your district and you may expect to hear from them in a day or two.

We urge upon you that you make a prompt response. Should anything happen that you do not hear directly, you may send your check, made payable to the order of Frederic W. Allen, Treasurer, mailing it to the Headquarters of the Committee, and your contribution will be credited to the Association in which you are assigned.

Above all, it is the hope that every Yale man shall have a part in the undertaking; that each shall give in such amount as his circumstances shall warrant, but that all shall give in singleness of purpose and spirit.
