McCraig has passed on your letter to me. Sir William Osler became a member of the Hebdomadal Council in Michaelmas Term, 1905. The full period of office is six years; but he resigned in October, 1908; his letter of resignation was received by the Council on October 19<sup>th</sup>, 1908. He had applied, and had received permission for, a year's leave of absence and dispensation from Professorial duties.

As to the functions of the Hebdomadal Council, I enclose a page from the Historical Register which explains these. The Council now consists, however, of three Heads,

Six Professors, and nine members of Corporation.
