My dear Doctor Osler,

I am not able to say positively that the work of Nicolaus Praepositus of 1471 is the earliest dated printed medical book, but I have always been accustomed to so regard it. Sprengel gives no earlier date, although, curiously enough. he does not seem to have detected the error in the date of the first edition of Valescus that was printed as 1401, and has been sometimes quoted with that date, which is clearly a blunder for either 1491 or 1501.

I thank you for your kind interest in the matter of the portrait. It has not yet arrived, and I shall be glad to let you know when it can be seen and to hear your opinion as to the likeness.
