My dear Dr. Osler,

Many thanks for your kind note in referenceto the Religio Medici which you bought in London. I have no doubt that your copy belonged to Coleridge. In addition to the Religio I possess, with notes by Coleridge, I have a copy of the Vulgar Errors with marginal notes and the initials S.T.C. The marginal notes in both books are in ink. The Vulgar Errors has on title-page the autograph of C. Lamb bought for S. T. Coleridge, and then in Coleridge's writing given by S.T.C. to S. Hutchinson, sister of Wordsworth's wife. I cannot tell you the very following(?) remarks in these two volumes. Jack showed them to you when you were here. I should be so pleased to see your copy so bring it with you and we can compare notes. I hope you will stay here a few days with me if only to see the Rylands Library.
