In fly-leaf of Mayerne's Sommaire Description de la France; Allemagne, Italie, et Espagne... (Rouen, 1640).

W.O. has written:- Editions appeared also in 1596, 1618, (Paris), 1618 (Glm), 1629, 1641 and 1642 (Fordham).

"In natural sequence to these French Itinéraires appear in 1552 a regular Road Book of the post roads of France, La Guide des Chemins de France, published by Charles Estienne which went through a number of reprints and editions extending from that year to as late as 1623; and, in 1591 the Sommaire Description de la France of Théodore de Mayerne & Turquet which was re-edited up to 1644".
