I regret to say I have no letters from Sir William Osler, a few years ago after reading a paper on Gastric Ulcer in Children before the Gastro-Enterological Society I received a postal card from Sir William written in commendation of my small effort in his familiar way calling it a "good bit of work". This unhappily has either been mislaid or lost for I do not now find it.

It was my good fortune to meet Osler in Vienna in the winter of 1873 where a number of us were thrown together at the Clinics. The only recollection is that he was a bright earnest forceful highly educated young man with most engaging manners and a tremendous incentive to hard and faithful work. We formed a friendship which has lasted through life, though alas circumstances have prevented my meeting him as often as I would have liked.
