January. (House visits largely, evidently for C.P. Howard, for when "Howard laid up" occurs. the number of visits increases greatly. At other times there are rarely more than 3 or 4 a week).

September 16, Sun. - Oct. 7, Sun. (Entries cease).

October 30, Tu. - Nov. 25, Sun. (Entries cease), *

* Opposite is an interesting reminder of the canvas of the Governors for the M.G.H. physicianship in 1878. I had been physician during the smallpox outbreak in 1874-5 and pathologist, but I had not been an assistant physician. However Howard and Campbell thought I might 'run' so I did against Frank Campbell. I had to see all the Governors and a d. - hard job it was. I had a large majority. The dictum was May 23rd. Geo. Ross and I left that eve for England where we spend 4 mos. I took my M.R.C.P. that year. (On the opposite page occurs a long list of the people that he saw at the various hospitals. etc. Radegoude & Victoria Sq. - 20 names; St. Francois Xavier, 9, and there follow names of McGill, Sherbrook, Notre Dame, St. Peter, St. Nicholas, St. Paul, Sacramen. He indeed must have seen 100 or more people and it was little wonder that 30 years later he refused to solicit testimonials from anyone, even for the Edinburgh Chair. H.C.)
