H.V. Ogden at family - you fear reading books in mathematics - got typhoid - had to give up grammar - father wanted him to take law - was going to America - went to Montreal 1878 - found not as difficult - not well taught - used to go to college library, took Latin Virgil etc etc - summer 1879 did nothing - fall of 1879 went back to McGill - (Wm Reynolds our uncle of Archie Mallock's medical H.V.O. got into medicine told him very difficult) Ogden's people somewhere - went to Canada after the war - met <sup>all</sup> Mrs. Reynolds who a bygone.

In fall of 1879 boarding house in cheap part of town - In Oct. Ogden sent for Ogden who had been attending his lectures - cutting sections free hand & using microscope. H.V.O. offered chance to share room with Rogers at 1307 St Catherine St. Privatized together.

Ogden and other students used to do antiques with W.D. who  
had about 7000.

They called Bullen the 'Lord Lord'. He was  
always trying to reduce the rent.

W.O. told Ogden his mother a gay high spirited woman  
 took a bun drum also person -

He was very swarthy and dark - more other -  
 the books by r and also W.O.

During 4 years 1878-82 Ogden lived with  
 W.D. and family every day to Francis House. Sat  
 breakfast at lady's dinner & lunch outside. W.D.  
 there every day on way to college. Willie was a  
 baby - Mary was 12-13 a charming girl. Older used to  
 track her to create Shakespeare, very dramatic -

W.D. used to be doing autopsies every day - Victoria  
 series of incisions - was severe in autopsy room - W.D.  
 would write them up from dictated notes -

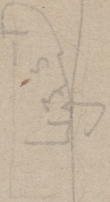

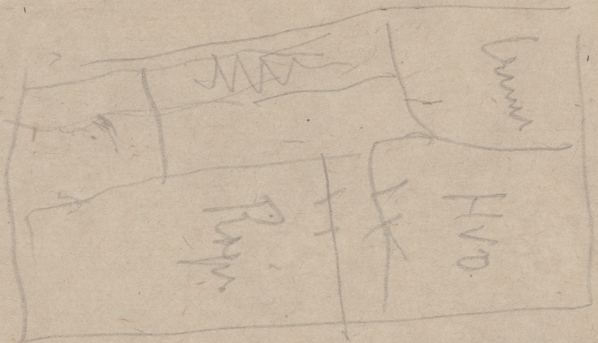


Staircase to

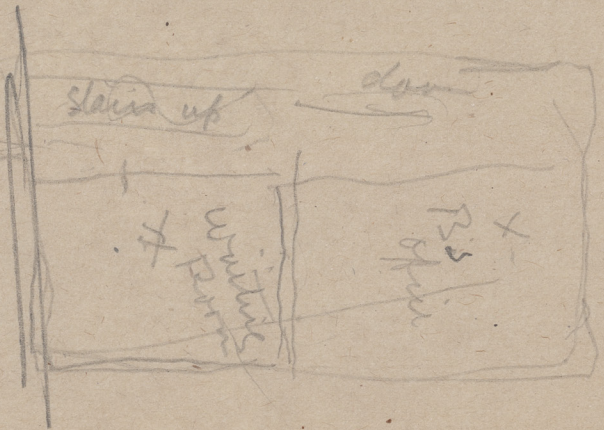

Ollama — Ogden said Hunter's Museum — W. O.  
And Eugene Smith? US Army Museum in Washington,  
A no longer sent student — unable to know why.
