(3) Has your mother by any possibility any late letters from him? I have one to Arthur Jukes Johnson, in June, 1879, in which there is no intimation of his own ill health though he is concerned about W. A. Johnson. Have you any later letters?

(4) Was your grandmother still living at the time; and who was with him at Nevis at the time of his death?

I hope you can answer some of these questions.
