Myth of relative to rheumatism

Infections endocarditis very important paper. 1881 very few ref, but later work, in American paper. It refers to infections to ulcerative etc. as latter of the same nature.

He thinks ulcerations commonest & vegetations later i.e. clots on them with deposits cut sections & studied them. More common in Pneumonia: meningitis & fragment elongation. Some bodies <sup>to</sup> regard as micrococci in valves similar to those Klebs had found.
