Before Path. Soc. of Phila., Sept. 24, 1885, W.O. says:-

"The liver fluke, *Distoma hepaticum*, so common in Europe, is not very often met with in sheep and cattle in this country, and in my experience it is rare to find here the advanced changes described in works on parasites. When in Berlin, in 1884, I spent two afternoons of each week at the abattoir, which, owing to the elaborate system of inspection, both ante- and post-mortem, offers one of the best fields in Europe for the study of comparative pathology and helminthology, and through the kindness of Dr Hertwig I was enabled to secure a large number of interesting specimens."
