DR. WILLIAM OSLER, of McGill University, Montreal, is prominently and favorably mentioned in connection with the Professorship of Clinical Medicine in the University of Pennsylvania, rendered vacant by the transfer of DR. PEPPER to the Chair of Theory and Practice of Medicine. Dr. Osler is widely known as a talented scholar, a learned clinician, and a popular teacher, and his election, which it is understood will be very acceptable to the Medical Faculty, would add undoubtedly to the high reputation which the University has always enjoyed.

Dr. Osler has just been invited to deliver, next spring, the Gulstonian lectures before the Royal College of Physicians of London, of which body he was elected a Fellow in May, 1883.
