My dear Dr. Cushing:-

Delay in verifying a date has delayed the answer to your letter to me of the 29th ultimo.

The Miss Pickton who came out from England with W.O. in 1884 ^{*Mary Anne Pickton*} was my mother's eldest and only surviving sister. She lived with my father and mother in their Wellesley Street ~~house~~ Toronto, from that time until her death in her 86th year in February 1886. She and W.O. were very deeply attached to each other and I believe she afforded him assistance in pursuing his studies in Germany.

The Aunt Lizzie you mention was my father's youngest sister Elizabeth. She attained a great age and died where she spent the whole of her life, in Falmouth, England.
