The Notes on Morbid Anatomy of Pneumonia was before the Path. Socy of Phila Apr 23 '85 - see this footnote -

" This with other articles on Morbid Anatomy which will follow from time to time will constitute my third and last Pathological Report from Montreal General Hospital."

Similarly there is a footnote to the Notes on the Morbid Anat. of Syphilis done and before the same body (date ??) stating that it is Part ^{IV} ~~III~~ Path. Rep. from the Hosp.

It must soon have been this up and the remaining papers presented 1882-87 were collected ~~as~~ and reprinted together in 1887 as from the Path. Socy. of Phila

Meanwhile in Montreal was his energetic influence renewed the literary activity of the ^{Hosp.} ~~the~~ full of fruit - and there were no subsequent reports.

After W.D. left Montreal Pathology ^{by} Ulyatt Johnson and was made Prof. - succeeded by Adams - Ulyatt Johnson a fine fellow but no lecturer & Adams took education to him.
