Not much change - about one paroxysm a day now and more expectoration. No fever. Temp. this eve 1000 and pulse good. The friction has cleared up. I told you I think of the acute pleurisy - on right side 3 weeks ago. No signs of effusion. The blooming thing started with paroxysms. I am always suspicious of the pleure with hard recurrent leath of cough after an acute pulmonary trouble. Fremitus and felt to the inner limit. Great sense of constriction and talking or movement at once beings on cough. Gen. Cond. good. p. warely over 65 - appetite Al. Curious attack. I am in my 9th week now.
