Dear Campbell:-

Not much change - about one paroxysm a day now and more expectoration. No fever. Temp. this eve 100° and pulse good. The friction has cleared up. I told you I think of the acute pleurisy - on right side 3 weeks ago. No signs of effusion. The blooming thing started with paroxysms. I am always suspicious of the *pleura* with hard recurrent *attacks* of cough after an acute pulmonary trouble. Fremitus ^{is} ~~and~~ felt to the *lower* inner limit. Great sense of constriction and talking or movement at once brings on cough. Gen. Cond. good. p. rarely over 65 - appetite Al. Curious attack. I am in my 9th week now.
