Dear Bowditch

You know how unreliable I am & will scarcely believe me when I say that my passage is taken for April 26th - Etruria - to Liverpool. I shall spend May & June knocking about the medical clinics in the smaller towns which I have not yet visited. I want particularly to see the arrangements of the clinical Laboratories & study the methods of teaching &c. July, I shall spend in England with relatives & friends. Shall be at the Congress in August & am due here Sept. 1st.

If you are in Dresden I shall go to see you first but I fear you may be in Italy or on the road, in which case we could meet later.

We are having a very comfortable winter. I like Baltimore, & the Hospital has prospered beyond our expectations. I have a nice keeping house for me.
