Aunt Grace was telling us recently of a trip they took up the river with Mr. and Mrs. Victor Horsley from Pangbourne to Oxford, two days' hard work. They had just landed and had nothing but town clothes, and it was hot, and W.O. had to row all the way. Horsley stopped at frequent intervals to boil tea in the kettle. Nobody else could drink the stuff. They arrived at Oxford about 10 p.m. and started at once in a slow train and on wooden third-class seats for London, arriving about 2 a.m.
