Post card from Dr. Henry P. Bowditch to Mrs. Bowditch, dated
15 Queens Park, Toronto, Aug. 18, 1897.

"Dear Selma

The journey was uneventful and the amount of sleep rather
insufficient, but the fruit was delicious and in great abundance.
Prof. Remsen and Mr. Rotch did all they could to help us but I
had to turn over about 2/3 of the basket to Osler who welcomed us
in his delightful way on my arrival. Foster and his wife are here
but Richet has not yet arrived. Dr. Stewart is here (he came on
the Parisian). He is delighted at the idea of going to the Shanty
where he may be expected to arrive about Sept. 7th.
