I am not making very rapid progress in the question of the relationship in the alcaptonuria cases. I have asked one or two relatives of the Jacksons, but they did not know, and I have not seen the patients themselves. I enclose you Futcher's report on the urine of the eldest son of the case he reported. You will see that the condition apparently exists in him. In the case of another son who consulted me a few days ago, a boy of seventeen, Futcher sent the report today that the urine is quite normal. I have written to Ogden of Milwaukee asking about his case.
