He has a rousing "pro-& con" murmur at the base & a M - syst. no enl. spleen. I sent you some choice smears today. Please look over for crescents as if it is astivo-autumnal fever they will surely be there. He had a small infection of the foot 2 mos ago. It looks like an endocarditis.
