(January to February crowded consultations)

March 14, Tu. - 22. Influenza, in bed. Fever 4 days, pains in joints and back. Coryza, larynx. bron.

28, Tu. - Sun, April 2. Atlantic City.

April 9 (during week) in South, Columbus Georgia, Richmond, Savannah - Consultations.

30, week of, - May 6. N.Y. and Bost.

May 2, Tu. Dinner in N.Y. by the profession.

Note. "Sailed from N.Y. by the 'Celtic' on the 19th - almost dead! Arrived in Oxford Sat. eve. Went directly to Mrs. Max Muller's house which we had taken furnished (No. 7 Norham Gardens) where we have lived until the middle of Jan. '07. We paid £ - 10/- a week for it & in the summer of '06 gave it up for two months to Mrs. Max Muller. I felt blue as indigo for the 1st two or three days. I was thoroughly worn out and it was 6 weeks or more before I felt myself.
