Dear Mr Phipps

I have handed over the Report to a very competent man whose judgement I will send you in a few days I will also look it over myself. I hope Mrs. Phipps is improving. What date in February would suit you to come down to the opening of the Tuberculosis Dispensary, which you have so generously given to us? Some day in the 2nd or 3rd week would be convenient. Your gift is bearing good fruit already - a citizen proposes to give \$15,000 to endow a nurse in connection with the Dispensary. I have been asked to bring to your notice the National Tuberculosis Society & its work. The enclosed circular tells of its aims & objects. We have secured a permanent secretary, a most efficient man, who will devote almost all his time to an active crusade. We have raised about \$9000. I shall be in New York next week & hope to see you.
