University of Oxford. - Degree of D.M.: In a Congregation held on November 29th, the degree of Doctor of Medicine was conferred on H. M. Turnbull, Magdalen College.

Radcliffe Travelling Fellowship. - An examination for a Radcliffe Travelling Fellowship, of the annual value of £200 and tenable for three years, will be held in Hilary term 1907, commencing on Tuesday, Feb. 26th. The examination will occupy four days. Papers will be set in physiology, pathology and preventive medicine, and a subject will be proposed for an essay. There will also be a practical examination in pathology. Candidates should send in their names, addresses, and qualifications to the Regius Professor of Medicine, University Museum, on or before Saturday, Feb. 9th, 1907. The conditions of the fellowship are published in the University Gazette of Nov. 27th, 1906, p. 197. Competition is no longer restricted to persons who have obtained either a first class in the final schools or a University prize.
