This is a very interesting paper indeed about Harvey, who must of course have used a magnifying glass, particularly in his embryological work. You have dug out a good deal of interesting information about him. I had to 'spade' over the same ground a few years ago for my Harvian oration. The Paris Faculty held out until 1672,- at least among the Paris theses I saw one last year by Bazin in which the old views maintained, and the conclusion at the bottom read, 'Ergo sanguinis circularis est impossibilis'! I am afraid I haven't a copy of my Harvian oration to send you, I will try to find one.
