- 18. Very severe attack, having a pain in right side, nausea, vomiting, sweating. $\frac{1}{4}$ morph. gave relief. Slight return in eve.
- 19. Returned slight in eve.
- 20. Bad attack middle day, morph. again. Good night.
- 21. Slight attack through day.
- 22. Ditto.
- 23. 1.30 - 5. Steady pain and down groin. Comfortable all night.
- 24. 8.30 passed uric acid calculus, and very well though very shaken and used up.
