Case No J.H.H. Surgical No 29150 - Hypophysial tumor

Jan. 25, 1912, Admission of Mr J.B.A. aged 33 - Pt. returns after having had a subtemporal decompression 7 months ago for relief of pressure symptoms and failing vision which began 3 yrs ago. <sup>Six months ago V.D. became nil</sup> Recently (2 or 3 mo) pt. has developed a left sided weakness and incontinence of urine in addition to aggravation of all previous symptoms. X ray

Eyes. Pupils about equal and small no direct or indirect pupillary reaction to light. No nystagmus no nystagmus. Movements of eyes rather jerky. Apparently some weakness of 2<sup>nd</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> + 6<sup>th</sup> nerves on the right. Fundi. Discs very pale with sharp somewhat irregular margins. Lamina cribrosa + optic cup obscured by a layer of new tissue. Arteries small. Veins not overfilled slightly tortuous. Slight amount of ~~new tissue~~ old scar tissue on large vascular trunks
