Dear Jacobs:-

We had a splendid trip 5 days and 21 hours from dock to dock. Revere is off with Campbell Howard in camp about 40 miles north of Quebec. I start on my rounds next Sunday - Montreal, Belleville, Toronto & Hamilton. Then to Boston about the 21st. I will come to you (Newport) for a day or two on my way to Baltimore. We sail on the 5th. I shall go to Contexeville to irrigate my rt. kidney as there have been twinges from time to time.

Campbell Howard has had a splendid offer from the University of Iowa - Dept. of Med., another benefit of the Carnegie report. I have urged him to accept though the school is small and it is far away, but they give him carte blanche, a good salary and two assistants at \$2,000 and \$1500.

This is a glorious place almost as bracing as Oxford and full of charming people.
