Dear Doyne,

At the Staff Meeting last evening the question was discussed of the relation of the ophthalmic work of the Radcliffe Infirmary and of the Eye Hospital. Very warm appreciation was expressed of your services, and they felt that the time mentioned by you, Wednesday at 3.30, was in every way suitable.
