- March 8, Fr. Revere ill Winchester. T, yesterday after a chill 105'. Found him with t. 105', slight pain right back, and embarrassed resonance with a few râles, no tubular breathing, no friction.
9. Sat. T. 101'. Vomited once in the night, evidently better, t, dropped on eve of 5th day and by 6 a.m. on 6th day was normal. Consol. came out well in upper half of lower right lobe. Never reached the extreme base.

- 7, Sun. - 13. Venice. Next week Rome, next week Cannes. (Consts. began Th. 25th. H.C.)
