Dear Sir William,

Mrs Richmond, a friend of mine and a graduate of the Glasgow Royal Infirmary, and I have just put in an application to Dr. Depag's hospital at La Paune, as we are desirous of getting work nearer the Front, having now been some months in the South, nursing at Dinan, C. du N. getting on very well with the French Red Cross, and they have treated us awfully well.

I believe you know Dr. Mallöck in the hospital, and I wondered if you would be kind enough to put in a good word for us, as we want to keep together, and we hear they will probably require more nurses in about a fortnight,

Did you see Elliott before he sailed? I hope Stewart Tupper is better.
