Do come direct to us at Oxford. You will probably get in on Sunday, the 20th, and there is a very good train that gets here late in the afternoon. Bring a couple of fellows with you.)

Keogh is willing now to accept a full unit from any one of the American Universities or from a combination of them, and one has been arranged between Harvard, Columbia and Johns Hopkins. 'Bob' Bacon made the final arrangements last week before he left. As at the Paris hospital, the chiefs are to stay for a short time, the subordinates for a longer period.

The McGill unit has just come over - 358 strong - and Revere has joined them at Shorncliffe.
