Dear Schäfer,

I was much interested in your Chlorine paper[#] as I have seen a great many of the gas cases. Haldane showed me two lungs which had remarkable fissures and fractures of the alveoli, quite unlike anything I have ever seen in ordinary lesions.

Where are Jack and Tom? I suppose J. was recalled. Revere joined the Canadian Army and was assigned to quarter-master's work at Clevedon, and now is with the McGill Unit at Etaples. We have had a number of the Canadian men with us and many relatives - 19 of the family are serving, and the wives are beginning to come over.
