Lday O. called at hotel for me, and we came down together. In the evening at American Club Sir Wm. gave an address on his life; described how in Montreal he copied lectures and read them. Trip to Europe, tossing coin to see if he should try for Phila., cherry-pie story and Weir Mitchell. Joke about J.H.H. and how women provided money if women students allowed in the medical school, and how he twitted Harvard people (he did not know at that time that the offer had first been made to them), that 33 and a third % of women students had married, within one year, Professors in school. Had to leave Balt. as he was at times almost at breaking-point, too much the servant of the public. The Rhodes scholars were very enthusiastic over the address. #
