Reason for W.O.'s appreciation of Mercier was due to Mercier's ^{arrangement} service ~~section~~ of Sir Oliver Lodge volume Raymond on Life & Death which had an enormous appeal to many people, O.W.O. thought it had done enormous harm - Published 1916. Mercier

Mercier's Spiritualism & Sir Oliver Lodge "came out" in 1917 (Examiner in Psychology in Univ. of Toronto) both in F.R.C.P. & G.P.C.S.
