Those spleen papers are most interesting. * I have had several ruptures operated on - typhoid and malarial and one (two?) malarial exploratory punctures with latent and fatal (!) haemorrhage. That infarct case is particularly interesting. We had one case from twist - a huge spacelus, which Halsted excised.

Worried now over a spleen removed one year ago from recurring haemorrhage - no attack until last week. I suppose the oesophageal piles persist.

What an experience you must have had in the East!
