Dear Fen. We had

We had the sad news last eve that Revere had been killed. We have no particulars only that Dr Harvey Cushing, our great friend, was with him. This is such a comfort as he & Revere were devoted to each other. He must have been at the Casualty Clearing Station to which Revere was brought. He wired at once, so we were warned. I never expected him to get through alive. We are of course heartbroken but shall try to face the ordeal bravely.

Frank & Belle are here, in a nice little house for a month. F. is so well & has been such a useful fellow at the Can Red + in London.
