Are you deep in an outbreak here, and I have been seeing such tragedies, my good friend Dr. Harvey of Witney died in 3 days, and his three children were desperately ill.

Very bad type. I saw two similar college students in same room, one moribund, the other very bad both, died within the week. Marked cyanosis diffuse broncho pneumonia, and astonishingly good heart up to the end.

Bill well and father goes to London Saturday for Board work.
