Dear Fen:

Thanks for your arranging about the transfer to the J. H. U. of the bonds. I enclose a brief schedule relating to the Trust. My general works on literature will go with his books.

One or two points about my will:

I. Leaving everything to Grace for her life. Could your Company act with her, as Executors; and after her death manage the estate?

Could the estate be left to McGill College, which would pay the legacies to relations for life, administer, and finally distribute?
