To the Hon. H.A.L. Fisher;

"About our P.-g. meeting, last Thursday we had our final meeting of all the representatives of the London medical schools, the P.-g Colleges, and the special hospitals, and passed finally the scheme which we wish to launch properly on the 29th April, R.S.Med. I was commissioned to ask you to take the Chair. We hope to have the American Ambassador, the representatives of the overseas Dominions and of other certain public bodies interested, and a selected group of laymen. I do hope you will be able to come and give us your blessing by taking the Chair. I will make a few introductory remarks, then we shall ask Newman to speak, the American Ambassador and one or two others. It has been a long job to get united action, but the schools are now very enthusiastic, and the scheme is one that should have far-reaching benefits for the numerous American and overseas P.-g students..."
