this eve - Sir William and I are having supper
alone !!!. --- Sir William will be in town
three days next week at the B. M. meeting for
Americans and Colonials - I am trying to get him
away to Cornwall for a week but he won't go.

--- Sir William has just had a letter from Professor
Lwenbeck in Vienna (he is Dutch & went there
from Strasburg, belonging in Grönning [??]) March 5th
They were nearly starving, no milk - no potatoes - vegetables
meat - beans or rice and had only had tough mutton
& hard bread for ten days. It is sickening.
