... It comes of course to a question whether Montreal is to keep in the van, and I am sure the Governors of the Royal Victoria and the Montreal General will move with the times. They cannot afford to do anything else, and after all, it's only a matter of reorganisation, and in the appointment of chiefs of clinic the practice to be followed would be that of Edinburgh and other places where a Committee of the University and hospitals is responsible for the nomination of the chiefs. It works perfectly well. I fully realise the heavy financial burden you have to carry.
