II A & R sell the whole of their Types presses &c and good will of Job Printing for the estimated value of Types, presses &c

uncontrolled use of one press

IV A & R to be at liberty should they  
think fit anytime after the ex-  
piry of nine months to purchase  
new types & presses for their own  
work & for printing Books  
Pamphlets, & Lots requiring  
to be ruled in their Binders  
~~or bound into Books~~ <sup>in their offtown</sup> or to  
continue even after the above

to get all work executed by  
Mr Abraham at the same

V A & R to have one column in the  
Gazette for their ads without  
out charge with liberty to  
change the same when they

after so long as Gazette or

any part thereof belongs to Mr  
A that they should have  
half a column without  
charge.
