

On this thirty first day of the month of January
in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and eighty three.

At the special Request of M^r Pierre Jules Godin,
Hotel-keeper, of the Town of Lachine, in the District of
Montreal, I, Léon Forest, the undersigned Public No-
tary duly commissioned in and for the Province
of Quebec, Canada, residing in the Town of Lachine,
in the said District of Montreal, in the said Province
of Quebec, personally went to the domicile of M^{rs}
Elizabeth Leishman, in the said Town of Lachine,
Widow of the late James P. Dawes, in his lifetime
of the same place, Gentleman, where being and
speaking to the said Dame Elizabeth Leishman
in person, I, the said Notary, did then and there
declare and notify unto the said M^{rs} Elizabeth
Leishman, at the request aforesaid, as follows:

1^o That on the eighth day of the month of February
last (1882) by Lease received and passed before the
said Léon Forest, the undersigned Notary, the said M^r
Godin rented from the said M^{rs} Elizabeth Leishman
a certain Stone house & its dependencies erected on a
lot of land known & designated under number one
hundred and eighty four (N^o 184) on the Plan and in the
Book of Reference of the Cadastre of the said Town of
Lachine, for the term of five years to be computed from
the first day of May also last past (1882) but with the
privilege, on behalf of the said M^r Godin, of leaving
the said rented house & premises on the first day of
May every year - "provided he would have notified
" M^{rs} Dawes on or before the first day of February
" previous, of his intention of so doing."

2° That the said M^r Godin now intends leaving the house and dependencies rented by him from the said M^{rs} Dawes, as aforesaid, on the first day of May next.

Therefore, I, the undersigned Notary, at the request aforesaid, did notify unto the said M^{rs} Elizabeth Leishman, speaking as aforesaid, that the said M^r Pierre-Jules Godin intends to leave and will leave, on the first day of May next (1883) the house & dependencies rented from her as aforesaid, as he has the privilege of so doing by and in virtue of the lease hereinbefore mentioned, requiring her to govern herself accordingly. And to the end that the said M^{rs} Elizabeth Leishman may not plead ignorance of the premises, I, the said undersigned Notary, at the request aforesaid, did serve the said M^{rs} Elizabeth Leishman speaking as aforesaid, with a duly certified copy of these presents.
