— Before Leon Forest the undersigned Notary Pu-  
blic duly commissioned and sworn in and for the  
Province of Quebec, residing in the Town of Lachi-  
ne, in the District of Montreal, — and in the actual  
presence of Andrew J. Dawes, Esquire, Brewer, and  
of St. George Knight, Book-Keeper, both of the said  
Town of Lachine, instrumentary witnesses hereto,  
and as such duly-qualified according to law.

— Personally came and appeared M<sup>rs</sup>. Madame  
Elizabeth Leishman, of the Town of Lachine, in the  
said District of Montreal, Widow of the late James-  
Powley Dawes, in his lifetime of the same place, Gen-  
tleman and Proprietor.

— Who being of sound mind, memory, judgment  
and understanding, and being desirous of disposing  
in view of death, of the goods and properties God has  
been pleased to bestow upon her, hath requested the  
said M<sup>re</sup>. Leon Forest, Notary, in presence of the wit-  
nesses above named, to write down and receive in  
due form of law her last Will and Testament,  
which she has declared in manner and form fol-  
lowing, that is to say: —

1<sup>o</sup> I most willingly resign my soul into the hands  
of Almighty God, my Creator, praying Him to  
receive it amongst the Blessed.

2<sup>o</sup> I desire that all my just debts, funeral and  
testamentary expenses be paid by my universal  
legatee hereinafter named, as soon as possible  
after my death.

3<sup>o</sup> I give and bequeath to Albert-Frederick Dawes,  
my



my only son, all the goods and properties which shall be found in my succession, at the hour of my death, in full property, and to that end, I institute and name him my universal legatee, under the charge of paying to his aunt Angeline-Martha Leishman, my sister, an annual rent of Three Hundred Dollars currency, during her life, - which Rent shall be payable to her by quarterly payments of Seventy five Dollars currency each, the first whereof shall become due and payable one month after my death, and thence every three months until she dies.

— The payment of that rent shall be made to my said sister in Lachine, or in the City of Montreal, by my said son, in order to spare him trouble.

4<sup>e</sup> I hereby expressly repeal and revoke all and every other testamentary dispositions which I may have heretofore made.

— The present Will and Testament was thus made and declared by the said Testatrix to the said undersigned Notary, in presence of the witnesses above named, and read by the said Léon Forest, Notary, in presence of the said witnesses, to the said Testatrix who declared to well understand the same, and to persist therein as containing her intentions and last Will.

— Done and Passed at the said Town of Lachine, at the domicile of the said Testatrix, on the day month and year first hereinbefore written, under the number Four thousand six hundred and thirty (<sup>no</sup> 4630) of the original Deeds of record in the office of the said Notary, and signed by the said Testatrix with and in the presence of the said witnesses and Notary also hereunto subscribing,
