Sir,

I have the honor, by command of the Honorable the Provincial Secretary, to call your attention to the fact that "Act to amend the law respecting Justices of the Peace," sanctioned by His Honor the Lieutenant-Governor on the 12th of January ¹⁸⁹⁸ ~~instant~~, requires that every Justice of the Peace must, within six months from the date of his appointment or the sanction of that Act, take the oaths necessary for his qualification as justice of the Peace, in default whereof his name will be struck off the list.

Accordingly, you are obliged to take the required oaths between now and the 14 Aug 1898
