I do hereby summon and warn you to be and appear before Her Majesty's Judges at the now next ensuing Sessions of the Court of Queen's Bench, holding Criminal Jurisdiction in and for the District of Montreal, at the Court House, in the City of Montreal, on *Thursday* the *first* day of *June* next at **TEN** of the clock in the forenoon, to serve as a GRAND JUROR.

I further notify you, as required by Article 2662 of the Revised Statutes of the Province of Quebec, that, if you intend to claim exemption from serving as such Juror, under Articles 2620 and 2621 of the said Revised Statutes, you must, within three juridical days from the service of this summons, furnish me with an affidavit in writing, sworn to before a Justice of the Peace, or before me, or my Deputy, establishing the ground of your claim to such exemption. If you neglect so to do, you will not be entitled to the benefit or such exemption.

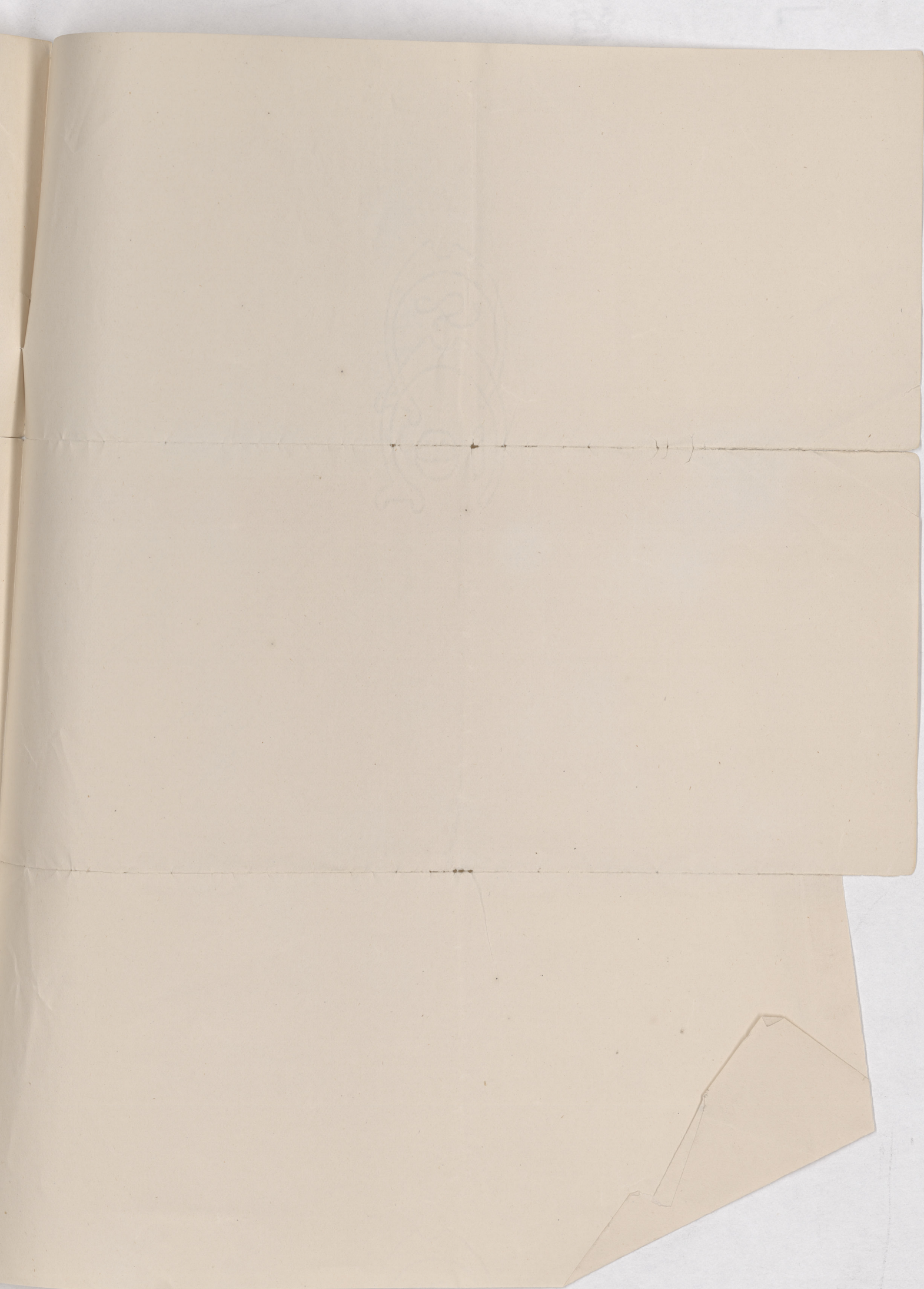
