In answer to your letter of the 17th July
last received at Key West making certain Enquiries from me
as one of the Inspectors of the late Election for Delegate to
Congress, I can only say, that you came to vote soon after
the opening of the polls: I believe no one was present but Mr
Geo Bartlett - Your vote was not challenge - I as one of the
Inspectors merely asked you if you were an American citizen,
you replied that you were born on the British side of the
line: What particular place I do not remember - You
continued your Statement and when it was concluded
the Inspectors being of Opinion that you were entitled
to vote, you were sworn and voted.
