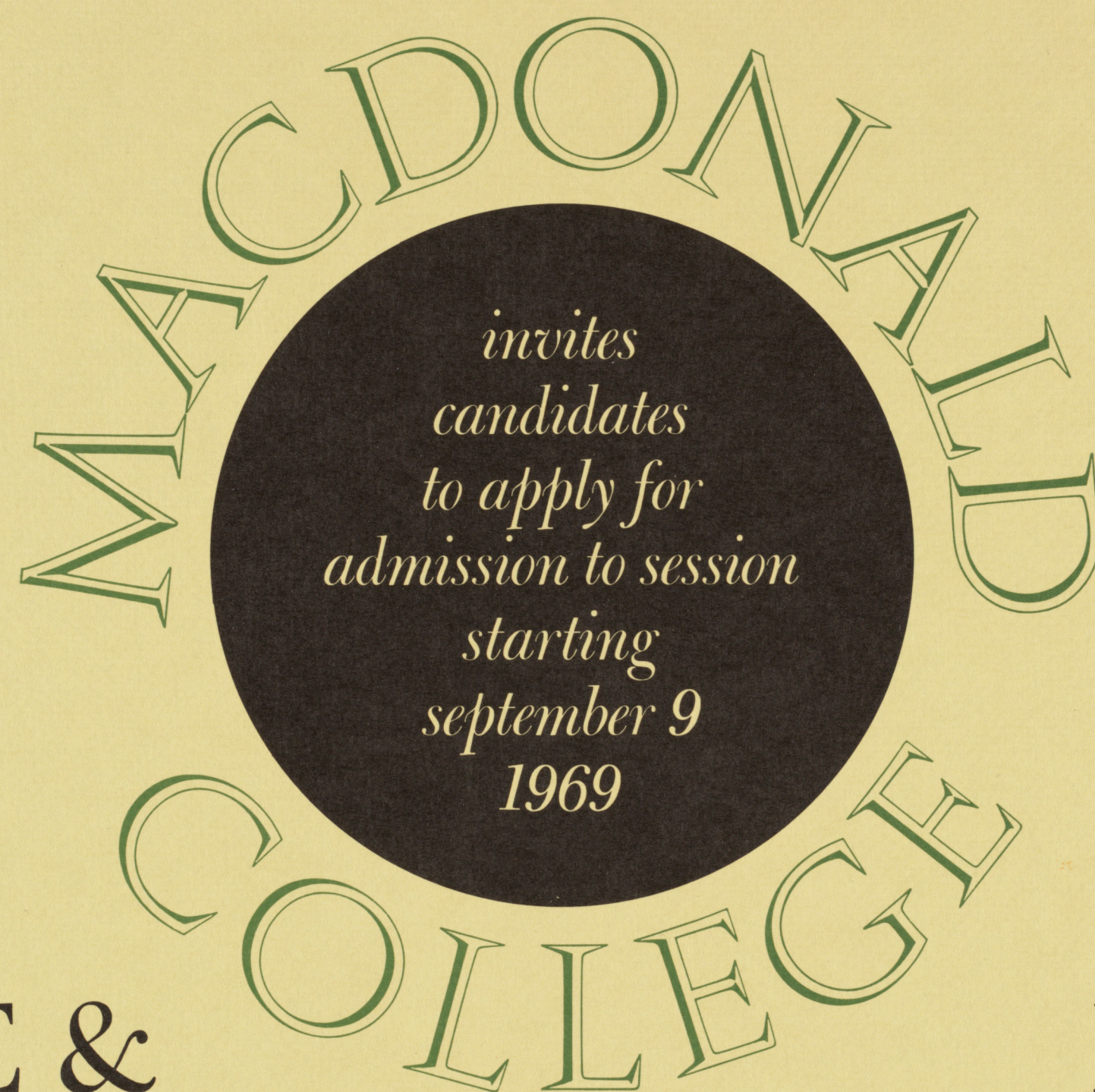

FOR ADMISSION TO FIRST YEAR: Quebec High School Leaving Certificate, 10 approved subjects, overall average 65%. "Service for Admission to College and University" Test Results. Ontario Grade XI and XII certificates (65%).

FOR ADMISSION TO SECOND YEAR: Quebec Senior High School Leaving certificate, 7 papers, overall average 60%. Ontario Grade XIII certificate (60%).

applications will be received to August 15th, '69.

CERTIFICATES other than the ones mentioned will be assessed for course equivalence by the Admissions Committee.

CANDIDATES having 75% average or better in the Christmas exams and who submit satisfactory "service for admission to college and university" test results will receive favourable consideration for early acceptance.
